






#### The Mediterranean lighthouse

<u>Objective</u>: preventing and eliminating pollution of our ocean, seas and waters

- Targets:
- Reduce by at least 50% plastic litter at sea.
- Reduce by at least 30% microplastics released into the environment.
- Reduce by at least 50% nutrient losses, the use and risk of chemical pesticides






